Preservation Database (NHPD), a unique tool that helps preserve affordable housing. **This** database offers the only de-duplicated source of address-level data for publicly supported housing properties.

- Risk Management Awards: Our annual Risk
 Management Awards honor outstanding efforts in risk
 control.
- Playground Safety Poster and Essay Contest: Residents can participate for the chance to win gift card prizes.
- Fire Safety Poster and Essay Contest: Residents can participate for the chance to win gift card prizes.

Each year, HAI Group hosts a virtual risk management conference, typically held in early November. This event is tailored to our members and features presentations from industry experts who share insights on emerging risks and practical strategies for mitigation.
